SIMPLE INTEREST RULES

FOUR PER CENT—Multiply the principal by the number of days to run; separate the right hand figure from the product and divide by 9.

FIVE PER CENT—Multiply by the number of days and divide by 72.

SIX PER CENT—Multiply by the number of days; separate right hand figure and divide by 6.

SEVEN AND THREE-TENTHS PER CENT—Multiply by number of days and double the amount so obtained. On \$100 the interest is just 2 cents a day.

EIGHT PER CENT—Multiply by number of days and divide by 45.

NINE PER CENT—Multiply by number of days; separate right hand figure and divide by 4.

TEN PER CENT—Multiply by number of days and divide by 36.

TWELVE PER CENT—Multiply by number of days; separate right hand figure and divide by 3.

The fee is 15c for value up to \$5; over \$5 to \$25, 18c; over \$25 to \$50, 20c; over \$50 to \$75, 25c; over \$75 to \$100, 30c; over \$100 to \$200, 40c; over \$200 to \$300, 50c; over \$300 to \$400, 60c; over \$400 to \$500, 70c; over \$500 to \$600, 80c; over \$600 to \$700, 85c; over \$700 to \$800, 90c; over \$800 to \$900, 95c; over \$900 to \$1000, \$1.00.
