The starting defense for the Young Bucks was Jamm'n Jake Grover, Cody "Bear" Grover, Jeffrey "Bulldog" Grover, Bobby "Roadrunner" Nicolls, Danny "Bronco" Nicolls, Jonathan Speedy Bundy, Defender Joel Bundy, Alex "The Great" Blucker, Quen-"The Hammer"

Mege and "Tornado" Tyler Mack.

The Youngs kicked off to the Silvers who marched down the field with "Big Boy" Bob Nicolls at the helm. "Big Boy" Bob Nicolls threw to Jonathan "Illini" Wildt who got to midfield. two interceptions. Jonathan "Illini" Wildt picked off a Young pass and returned it to the Youngs' 15.
