

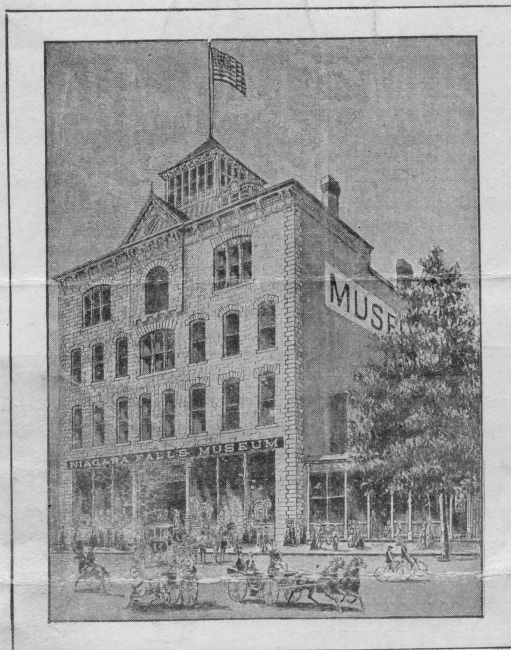

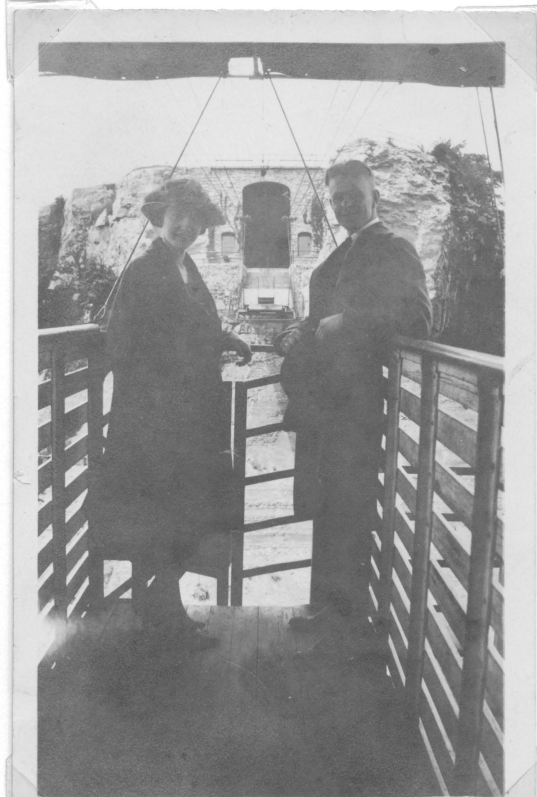

WEDDINGS McCoy-Nicolls

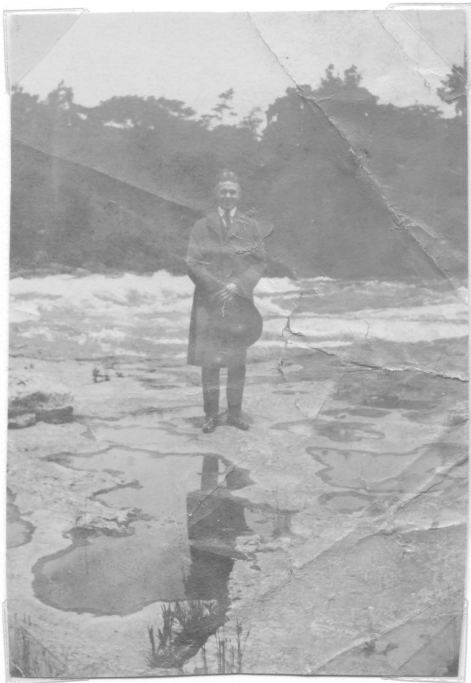

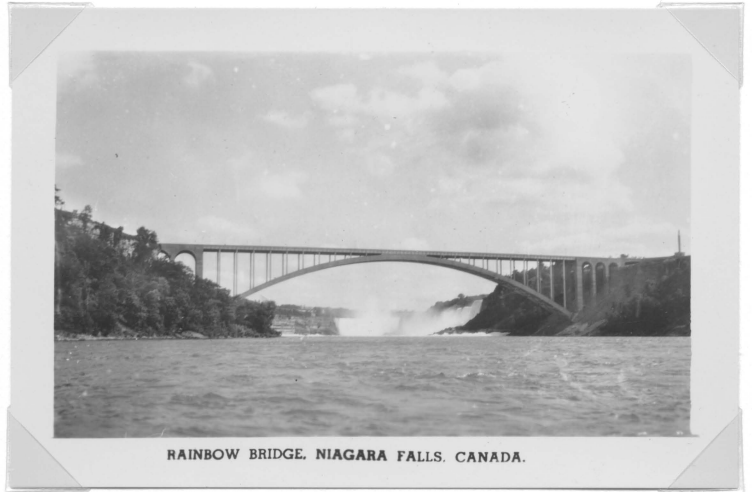

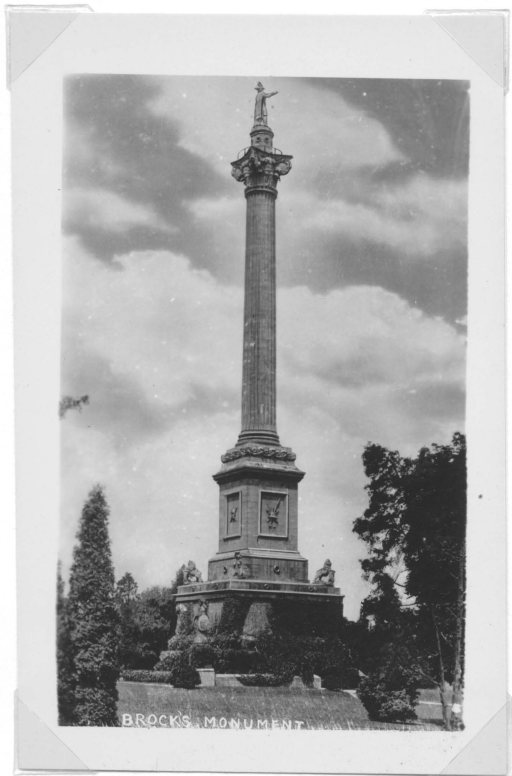
