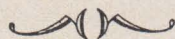

treatment at 10:30.
wrote to Dave P. m.
Ruth Hahn called.
Mary & J. Wallace in.
Stoh got his notice
today - the 14th.

JANUARY 4

Cloudy damp day.
went to Carlsons again.
Can't see any improve-
ment in how I feel.

Rachel over P.M.

Ruth & don to B. B. game
had to stop to kill chickens
eve.

Letters from Gene & Betty.

Bob arrived at
11:30 tonight looking
wonderful. He came
into P. of Sun. night
- to Camp Kilmer - to
Indian town gap & so
home - discharged.

JANUARY 5

A Beautiful Sun Shiny
Warm (70°) day. It's
a wonderful day.

I got up at 8:30 -
'cause Bot was up &
felt I must see if
he was really here or
I'd been dreaming last
night. He's real & so
good to look at. Grandma
was really surprised.
We sat around & talked
most of the day. Dad
came home Sat 3:30.
Don went down to the
store for him. Covers
(Ann Bouse & Grandma C.)
were up awhile tonight.

JANUARY 6

Another warm day.
Sunny part of the day
& misted rain around
noon. Got up around
noon - feel some
better today. Bob
opened his Chr. gifts
today, so I guess Christmas
is over & will take the
tree down tomorrow.

game.

at 9 & then cause Bob

back at 11. He going to
try to get home this weekend.

JANUARY 8

Cloudy day. Warm.

I came down about 10.
Grandma ironed. I got
lunch, & made a pie
& jello P.M. Then had
to rest. can't see on my
feet much. Crocheted on
Ruth's gloves eve. Packed
some eggs & soap chips
for Betty & a box for
Gene. Boby put Quince

& then called Sarah.

JANUARY 9

Betty's 24 today. got
a card from her. and
she's just 'waiting'. It's
raining part of the day.
Still warm like spring.
Bob cleaned out his

Raining hard tonight.
Don, Bob & Dad went

expendable".
Finished Ruth's mittens.

JANUARY 11

Bob, Don + Ruth went

tonight. I went to bed
early + got up at 2 a.m.
cause we expected Dave
in then. Don + Bob met
the train but he wasn't
on it so we went to bed
+ when Dad got up at
6 a.m. he had just come
so every one got up then.
So now I have 3 boys
(men) here at once.
They're playing cards
with Dad tonight.

JANUARY 29
