(Thursday.)

Jan 1. - 1914

Since this is the first of the year, I have made some resolutions; (1) to not be saussy; (2) to not use bad language; (3) to obey my parents; (4) to help my parents; (5) to do and say kind things; (6) to be merry. Carl is cross today. He has a cold and is cutting teeth. I went skating this afternoon and stayed from 2 o'clock till 4 o'clock. A little fat boy came on about 7 o'clock. He was just learning to skate, and could hardly stand up. Carl hit a fly this evening. He did not kill it, but only

crippled it.

(Friday.)

Jan. 2 - 1914.

I did not go out much this morning. Papa went to Youngstown and Struthers to the banks this afternoon. I had to the baby while mamma watched shop. Carl went to sleep then and I went down on the ice. I stayed from 3 o'clock till almost 5 o'clock. I went ^{along} up creek an awful ways today for the first time this year. Ruth Leslie, Harriet Davis, Howard Covey, Charles Endress, I van Blackman, and I were the ones. The doctor came to see Carl to-night. He left him some tablets and a bottle of

medicine. The doctor gave
Carl a pill, but he would
not take it. After a while he
put it in ~~my~~ mouth, but I did
not like it. Carl held a pencil
as good as anybody tonight.

(Saturday)

Jan. 3.-1914.

Well it has snowed all day today. Papa is sick. He has the sore throat and a cold. There isn't a bit of skating now. The ice is all covered with snow. Papa says "you can't find the ice." I went out in the yard and made a snow-man this afternoon. I had two pieces of shingles for arms, a little piece of wood for a nose, and coal for eyes and teeth. Then I got a cap and put on him. Uncle Jim and I kept store tonight. We closed at 9:30.

(Sunday.)

Jan. 4-1914.

The snow is about 2 ft. deep, and it is still snowing. Papa and I have the tonsclitis. I saw a Cardinal Bird, a Gapsucker, and a snow-bird today. We put some suet out for them to eat. The trolley-wire broke today and the street-car could not get further than Charlie Austers. They got it fixed this evening.

(Monday.)

Jan. 5-1914.

Papa is some better today, but I am not much.

The Street-car got up the hill today. Uncle Jim is working for us today. I have been in bed all day today.

(Tuesday.)

Jan. 6 - 1914.

I came downstairs
this morning. I am feeling
better today. I can't sit up
or I get sick. I haven't
much to write about to-
day.

(Wednesday.)

Jan. 7-1914.

I am feeling much better today. I have not laid down much today. Mamma went down to see Aunt Bess this afternoon. After we went to bed last night we heard some kind of a whistle and Papa says, "It's my automobile horn." Then mamma went down and turned it off. It had been blowing for about a half-an-hour. My throat is not sore today and I feel almost all right this evening. The doctor did not come today. I pared the potatoes for supper.

(Thursday)

Jan. 8-1914.

Well I am about
alright today. It has
thawed today like every-
thing. I got 2 notes from
school; one from Harriet
Kurtz, and the other from
Mollie Gould. Mamma
went to town this after-
noon. She got me a game;
"Whirl-it," and a book; "Dorothy
Arnold's Escapes." I have it
about half read. Aunt
Bess died about 6:30 P. M. 77
Mamma has a head-ache
tonight.

(Friday.)

Jan. 9-1914.

Mamma is sick today. I was out and had my shoes on today for the first time since last Saturday. I do not feel very well this evening Mrs. Alfred Arnold is having a chicken supper for some young hospital nurses tonight. Papa and I have to do the work. I have finished the book of "Dorothy Arnolds Escape." The snow is melting fast. It is cooler this evening though. I have not been to school this week.

(Saturday.)

Jan. 10-1914.

Mamma is about the same today. It is snowing a little bit and is pretty cold too. Papa and I went to Aunt Bessie's funeral, which was today.

Papa was pretty busy tonight. He did not open the shop today at all until about 4 o'clock this afternoon.

(Sunday)

Jan. 11-1914.

Carl is sick today.

The doctor came to see him.

We think he has the ear-

ache. His neck is a little

stiff. The doctor says he

has "enlargement of the

glands." Carl just cries

all the time. He wants to

be carried all the time too.

I cut out a puzzle and

put it together today. I

am going to send it away.

I have got the sore throat ^{now}

again. Mamma has the

neuralgia in one side of

her face.

(Monday.)

Jan. 12-1914.

Well it is snowing this morning. Carl sort of whines today, he does not so loud like he did yesterday. I went over to the post-office today. That was the only time I was out only on the front porch to look for the paper. The snow drifts an awful lot. The doctor came tonight again. I felt pretty good this morning but I don't feel very well this evening. Carl sleeps about all the time. The doctor says that its good that he does. I am not going to school for a

few days yet. It is awfully
cold today.

evening. I got a card in
the mail from Ralph to-
night.

Jan. 16-1914.

The snow is melting fast. Carl is better and is playing on the floor.

Grandma Spitzer came up to Aunt Ida's this morning, then came down to our house this afternoon. I got a note from Mollie Gould. Pearl brought it in after school. I went down to Grandma M^{rs}. Coy's this afternoon. She did our washing today. About half past six to night our school bell began to ring, and rang for about 10 minutes. Papa went over to see what was wrong. Nellie Logan's lamp exploded, she got a

bad cut in her hand. I have
not been to school this week.

ed turkey. Papa went to
town this afternoon. Mam-
ma and I went over to
the church to hear Mr.
Rutlage the Anti-Saloon
League man preach.

(Monday)

Jan. 19-1914.

Well I started to school today. Carl didn't get up until half past eight. We have our turkey all eaten up now. Papa is cutting ice today.

He has working for him; John Seeper, Wane Wakefield Mr. Wakefield, Bob Walk, and a few others. Mildred and Florence were in this evening.

(Tuesday)

Jan. 20-1914.

I went to school today. Uncle Jim is working in the shop for us. This is an awful day. It is muddy and everything is wet and sloppy. It is raining a little bit this evening.

(Wednesday)

Jan. 21-1914

I didn't go to the school today. I wasn't feeling very well. It is pretty cold today, and it snowed awfully hard for a little bit this morning. Mamma went to town and Carl and I were alone. She got Carl a rubber ball, and for me she got goods for a dress, two ribbons, and 2 note-books.

(Saturday.)

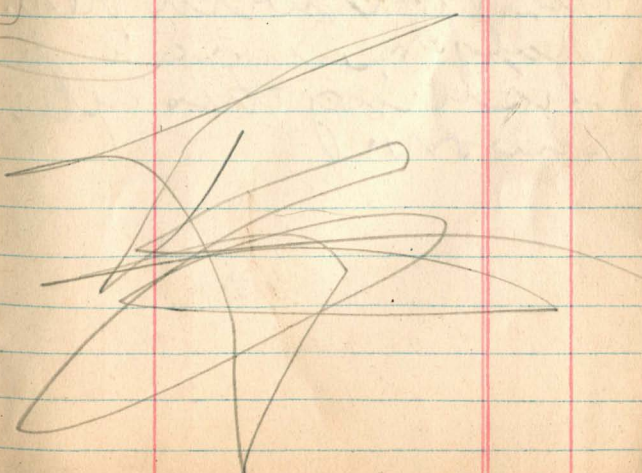
Jan. 31-1914.

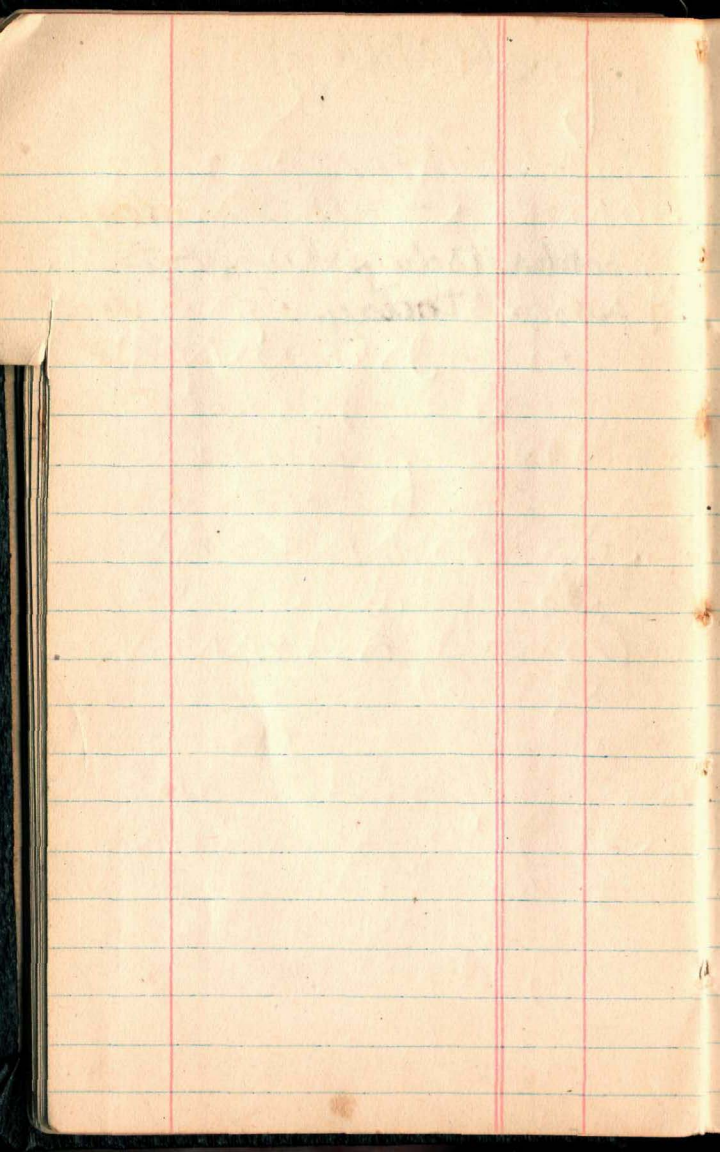

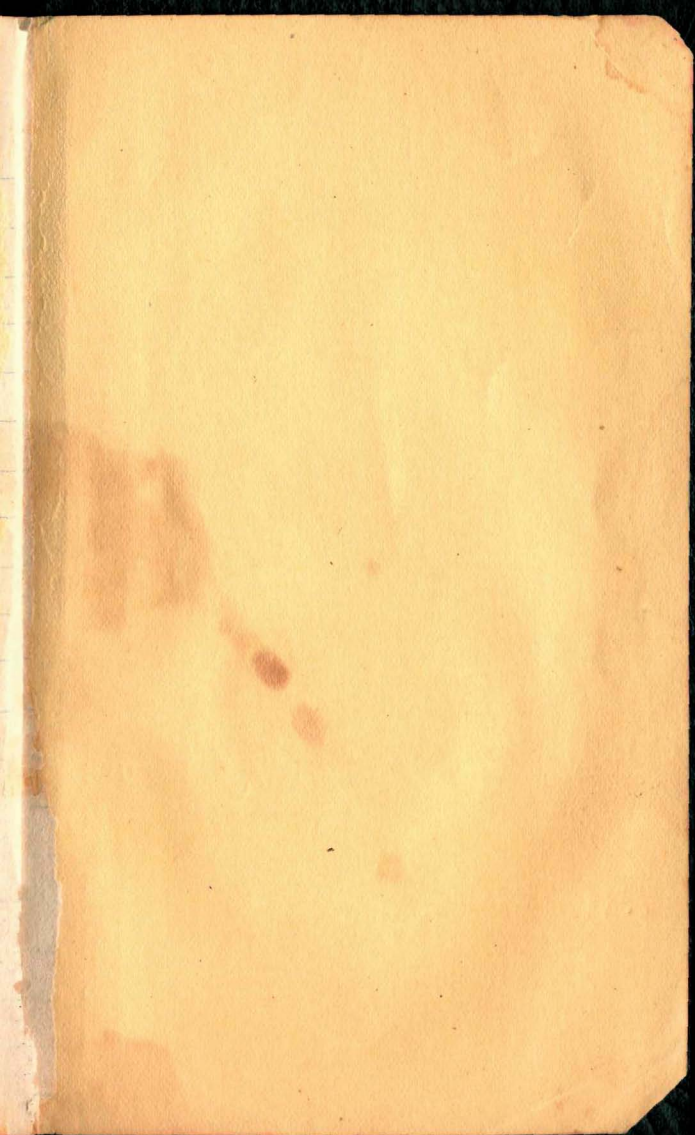
